EcoCup is the first screening of new ecological films from all over the world here in Moscow. It is a new and interesting format of cinema, and an original idea for getting the environmental movements message to more people here in Russia.

**The Opening Meeting will be February 24<sup>th</sup> at 18.00 at Space "Nauka254"** with the Russian premiere of the Finnish film "**Recipes for Catastrophe**" by Finnish Director John Webster.

The first screening of "**Plastic addicted**" by Canadian director Ian Connaher and "**Age of Stupid**", for the first time in Russian language will be shown for you at the Festival on February 25<sup>th</sup>.

February 27 and 28 are the Special Days in "Nauka254". **Saturday 27** – Eco-Architecture with Green Building Council. On February 28th the Film of the day is "**Last call for planet Earth**" by **Jacques Allard**. Mr. Allard will be the Special Guest of our Festival.

**Sunday 28** will be dedicated to **Reserves** in Russia with Eco-Center "Reserves". Another theme of the Day – is **Volunteering** in Russia, and in the world.
